Poole Park Lake

Sat 8th and Sun 9th May 2010

Eligible competitors are those holding current MYA membership in the UK and those members of clubs overseas who are affiliated to a Division Member of the ISAF-RSD. Skippers should be of good standing with their National Authorities. To classify as a veteran they must be at least sixty years of age by the first day of the competition.

Entries will be accepted by post, using the pro forma supplied in the MYA Yearbook Diary or on-line via the MYA website. Cheques (£15.00p) should be made payable to PRYC and should be sent to Roy Cane, 1 Arne View Close, Dorchester Road, Upton, POOLE, BH16 5RY to arrive before the closing date for entries of Sat 24th April 2010. Late entries will attract a surcharge of £5.

Location: A map is shown on the host club website (www.pryc.co.uk). For those using sat. nav. The nearest postcode is: BH14 8AN and the map reference is: SZ 026 908.

Transport: The nearest airport is BOURNEMOUTH INTERNATIONAL some ten miles distant and the nearest railway station is POOLE, about a mile from the lake.

Accommodation can be found at the Express Holiday Inn www.HolidayInn.co.uk which is a mile from the venue. Or, failing that, the Poole tourism website: www.pooletourism.com will supply the necessary information.

Registration: The lake is available for practice at any time but registration will commence from 14.00hrs on Friday 7th when the Clubhouse will be open. Check measurement may be carried out and competitors are advised that their registration certificate will be required. The briefing will be held at 9.45hrs on Saturday 8th and racing will start at 10.00hrs.

Racing will be conducted under the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing. Sailing times will be as the MYA SSI's. or as modified by the Race Committee and advised beforehand.

Presentations will take place at approximately 16.00 hrs on Sunday 9th May.

Storage of boats is possible in the Club Boathouse but space is limited and no responsibility can be accepted by the Club for loss or damage however caused.

Catering: Beverages will be available throughout the event together with light snacks. Sandwiches will be made to order for lunch. Orders by 10.00hrs.

On Saturday evening a fish and chip supper will be organised at the Clubhouse for those requiring it. Orders by 10.00hrs on the Saturday please..
